



BECOMING CATHOLIC is an adult formation program leading to initiation into the Catholic Church. During a program of about 14 weeks, participants read and view materials we provide, spend time in prayer and reflection, and journal weekly. On Sunday from 9:40-10:50am, the group meets with the program leaders to discuss assignments, pose questions, and learn more about the Catholic faith. Depending on their background and faith history, participants may be fully accepted into the Catholic Church at the end of a 14-week period. Others may continue a customized plan of formation beyond that period.

We also invite confirmed Catholics to participate as a way of learning and reviewing more about their faith. They may come for their own continuing formation as Catholics and, if they wish, to support those who want to become Catholics as mentors and sponsors, provide hospitality and other support. We are always happy to grow our team!

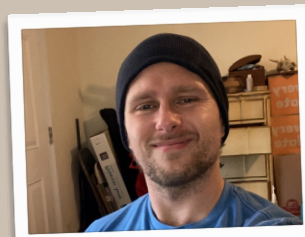
